MOBILE BIDDING INFORMATION



- Check your email inbox (from "Beer Fest Info") or our text (from TofinoAuctions) and click on the link to your personal invitation to bid.
- 2. Enter your online "handle" (the name you want to bid under) and vault your credit card (optional).
- 3. Click the "catalog" button to browse items.
- 4. To bid on an item, click on the item and enter "Max Amount" you want to bid. Your bids will be placed automatically, until the "Max Amount" is reached.
- 5. If you are outbid, you'll see a flashing alert in the upper right-hand corner of your screen and will get a text notification soon after.
- 6. If at the end of the auction you have the winning bid for an item, you'll receive an email notification that you won! Bidding closes at 8:00 pm CST on Friday 9/18, so you will NOT get a notification on the night of the event.
- 7. Some prizes are only available for individuals local to the Chicago area due to shipping constraints. More info on this will be included in the description of each prize. Items will be shipped/sent out the week after Beer Fest.
